**Notice of COVID-19 Vaccination Programme –
Vaccination Arrangement for Primary and Secondary School Students (II)**

Regarding to the advice of the Advisory Panel on COVID-19 Vaccines, the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Government (HKSARG) approved the lowering of the age limit for receiving the “Comirnaty vaccine” to age 12. In order to protect the health of primary and secondary school students, starting from 14th June 2021, the “COVID-19 Vaccination Programme” implemented by the HKSARG will cover adolescents aged 12 years or above. This adjustment helps reduce the spread of the virus in the community and enhance the overall immunity of the community. In addition to making an appointment for vaccination on the COVID-19 vaccination plan website (<https://booking.covidvaccine.gov.hk/>), students aged 12 years or above can also be vaccinated through their school’s arrangement.

In response to the Education Bureau, students are encouraged to be vaccinated against COVID-19 as soon as possible. Therefore, we have contacted with the Civil Service Board to make an appointment for the COVID-19 Vaccination Programme in Group Bookings for 20 – 30 students for vaccination at Community Vaccination Centre with school bus service arranged by the government. As a result, the COVID-19 Vaccination Programme has initially reserved the vaccination dates to our students on 23rd July 2021 P.M. and 13th August 2021 P.M. for the first and second doses of vaccine respectively. Nevertheless, since the parents’ letter which was issued on 25th June 2021 inquiring about the intention of Group Bookings of vaccination for your child/guardian arranged by school, we only receive 6 reply slips with consent forms by 6th July 2021. It does not meet the eligibility of the COVID-19 Vaccination Programme to participate in this Group Bookings of vaccination in a group of at least 20 people. Therefore, it is unable for us to arrange your child/ward to receive vaccination at Community Vaccination Centre with school bus service this time. We apologized for any inconvenience caused.

If your child/ward has submitted the reply slips with consent forms to their mentors before, the forms will be properly destroyed. Additionally, parents/guardians may also make their own booking through the website of COVID-19 Vaccination Programme direct for their child/ward to receive vaccination. Persons aged under 18 must bring along the “Consent Form for COVID-19 Vaccination” completed by their parents/ guardians to the CVC for vaccination.
